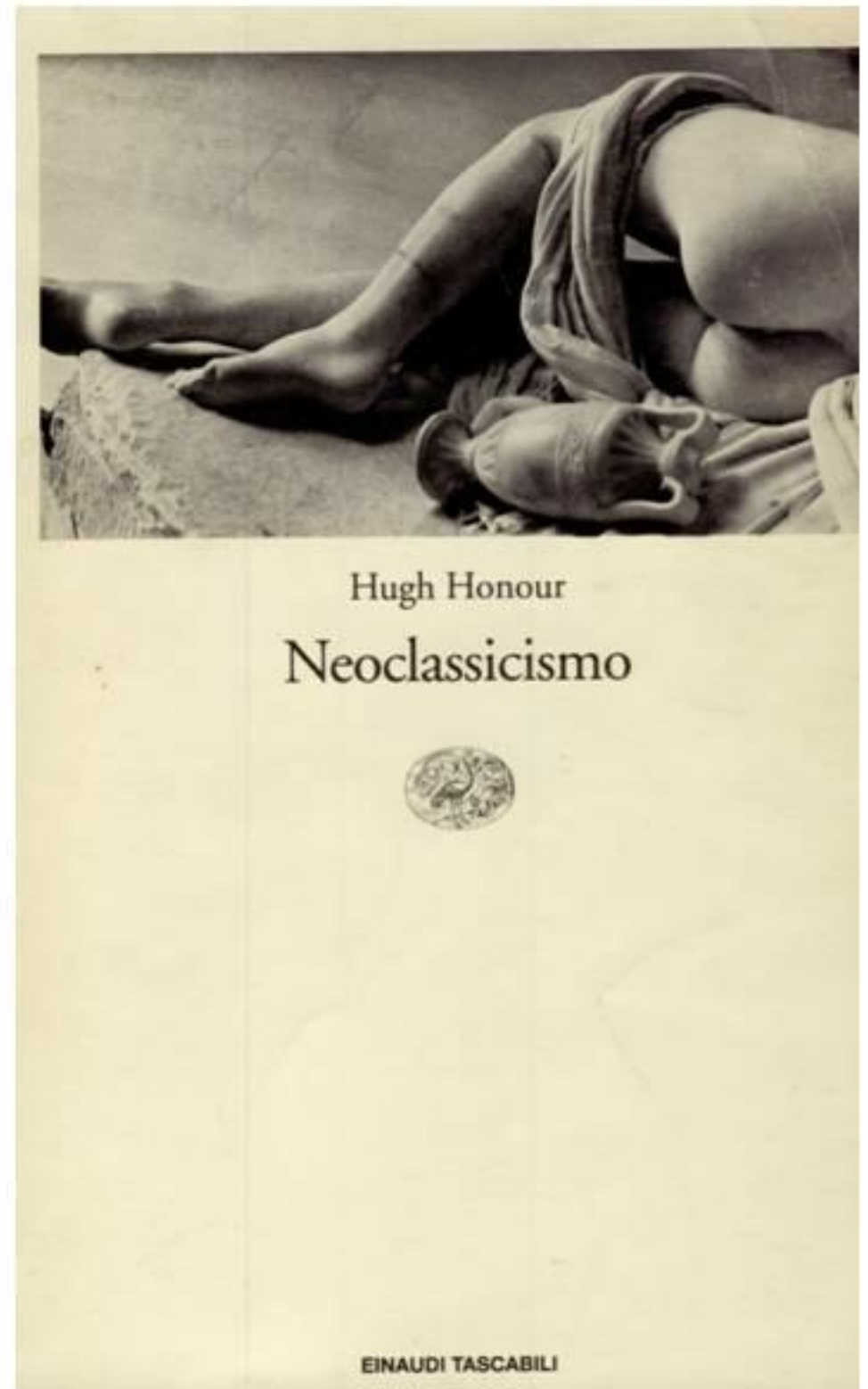
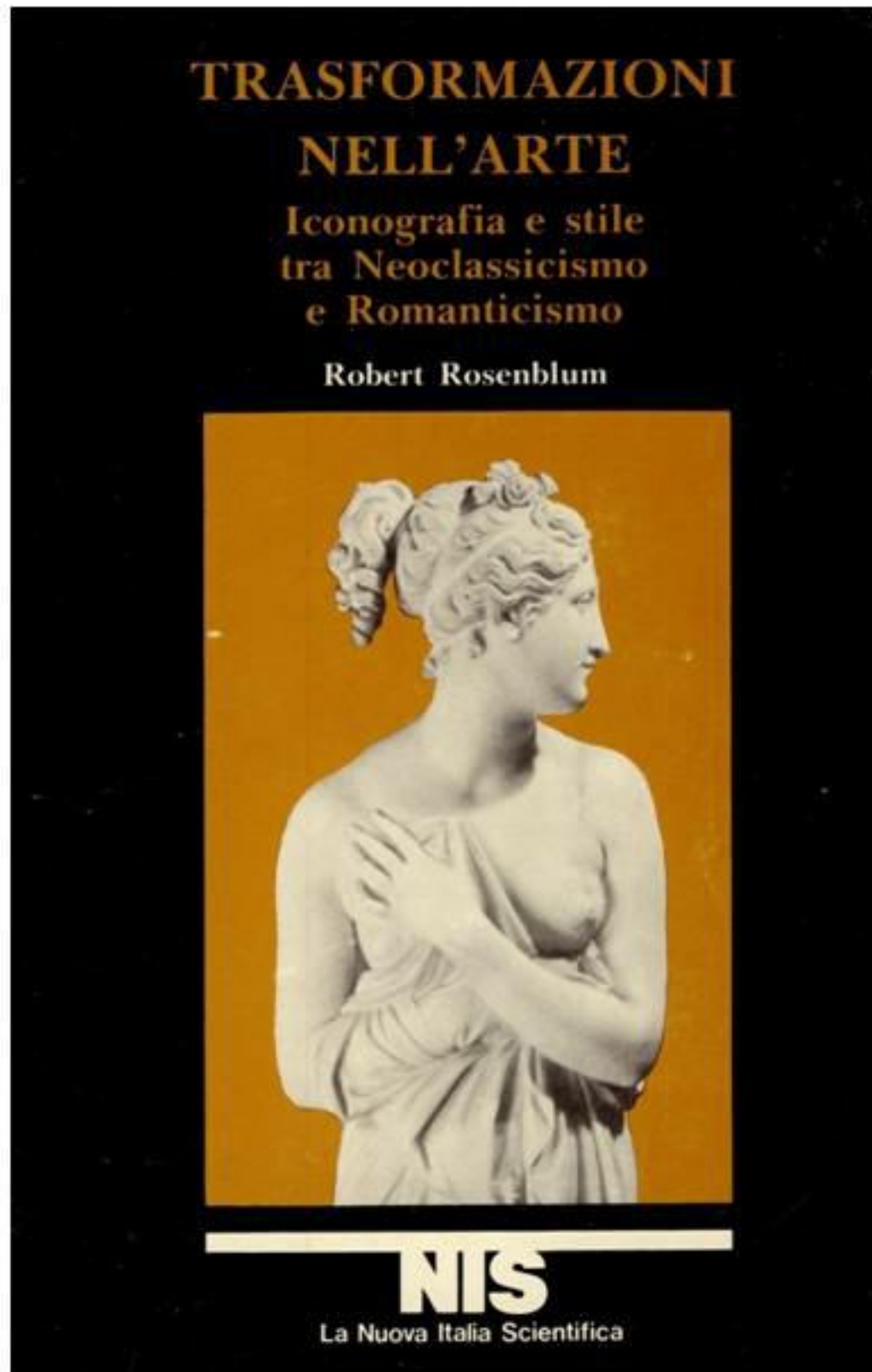




Fig. 1 - Giacomo Zoboli, Morte di Cesare. Perugia, coll. Buitoni.

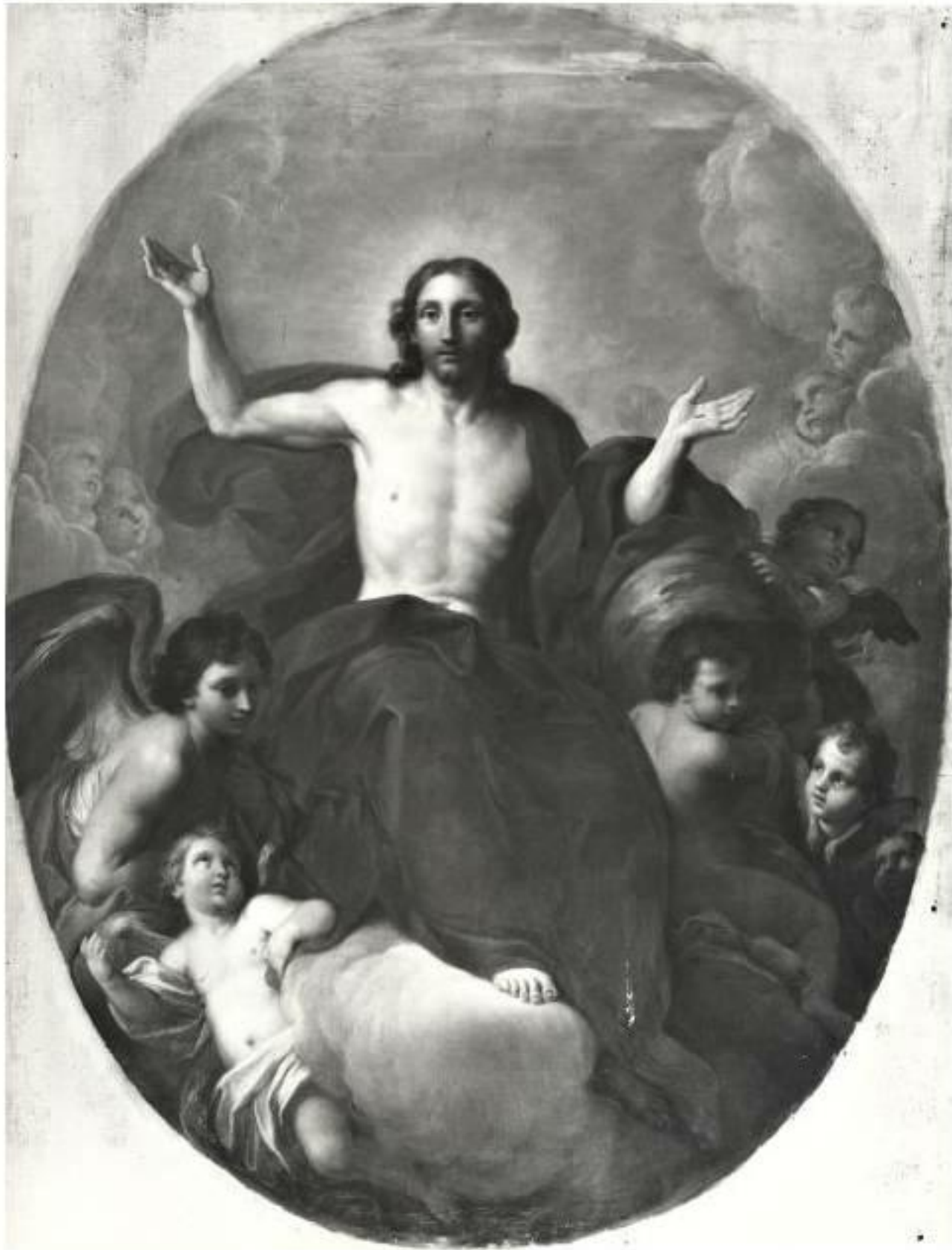
